June 5 – 9

Morning: Art World Explorers

June 12 – 16

Morning: Claymation Creation

Learn simple and fundamental techniques to transform clay into characters and scenes that can be brought to life through animation. Instructor, Nicole Reno

Afternoon: Textile Arts

From weaving and printing on fabric, to creating plush animals and monsters, learn how much fun it is to create unique art with textiles. Instructor, Nicole Reno

June 19 – 23

Morning: Stop Motion Animation

Morning: Paper Magic
