



The Mary M. James Student Inspiration Fund - Application

The Mary M. James Student Inspiration Fund was established to support student-created projects related to the mission of the Harn Museum of Art. These projects may be pursued by an individual or group, and funds may be used to cover expenses such as travel, materials and research supplies, and access to archives, among other items. Awards generally range from \$250 - \$1,000. For all proposed projects, **museum staff who will be involved must be contacted well in advance** to ensure that they support the project and will be available as needed.

Eligibility: Currently enrolled students at the University of Florida are eligible to apply for the grant.

NOTE: Applicants who have received this grant in the past should disclose how the funds were used and the results of the project in applying for additional grants from this fund.

Deadline: Applications will be accepted this year through Monday, May 1, 2017. In future years, applications will be accepted once each year on the last Friday of each March.

Applications will include the following six items:

- 1) Application form (below).
- 2) A completed budget form detailing proposed use of the funds (below).
- 3) Staff Support-of-Project form completed by Harn Museum staff member (below).
- 4) The applicant's resume.
- 5) A project description. Please describe your proposed project in no more than two pages, addressing the following:
 - a. The purpose and goal of the project;
 - b. How the project relates to the mission of the Harn Museum of Art;
 - c. The activities to be undertaken during the project;
 - d. The time frame of the project;

- e. The plan for disseminating project results. This must include plans to report back to the Harn Museum on the results of research (e.g. a presentation or written report), and may also include, but is not limited to, a conference paper or poster (please indicate potential conferences); a publication; a presentation at a university venue.
- 6) Letter of reference from a UF faculty member or other individual able to discuss your ability to complete the proposed project.

Proposal Review: Applications are reviewed by a selection panel composed of three members of the Harn Museum staff. These reviewers may not be experts in your field, so be sure to write your proposal with non-experts in mind. Proposals will be evaluated using the following criteria:

- Is the significance of the project clearly articulated?
- Do the proposed activities support a specific question, problem or hypothesis?
- Does the proposal demonstrate familiarity with scholarship in the field, showing the relevance of this project?
- Does the proposal explain a guiding process and/or methodology?
- Are the project goals and design adequately stated?
- Will the project be completed in the proposed time frame?
- Is the budget cost-effective?
- Is there a reasonable plan for disseminating research?
- Is the project relevant to the mission of the Harn Museum of Art?
