Who was Jonas Lie?

Jonas Lie (Norwegian, 1880-1940) immigrated to the United States in 1893 and studied at New York City's Art Students League and the National Academy of Design. His cityscapes were celebrated in his day for merging his close observation of subjects with the bright palette and vigorous brushwork of Impressionism. "Color," Lie said, "is the chief medium through which we attain pictorial expression; but color must be interpretive, not imitative."

What is a cityscape?

In the visual arts, a cityscape, or urban landscape, is an artistic representation of the physical aspects of a city or urban area. *Street Scene, Market Place* depicts a fish market in the Gammel Strand of Copenhagen, Denmark.
